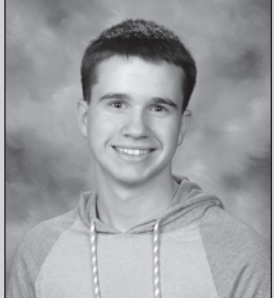

A: "A teacher yelled at us because we were watching something they put on the board."

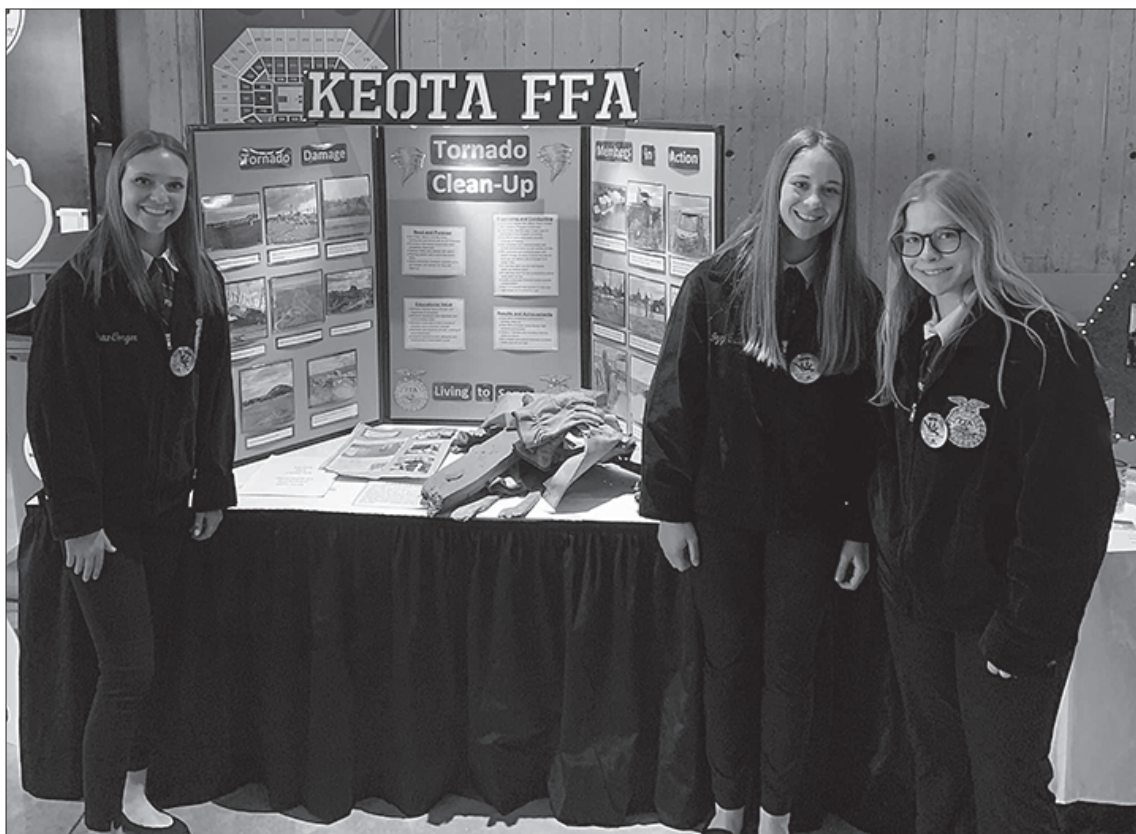


12th:
